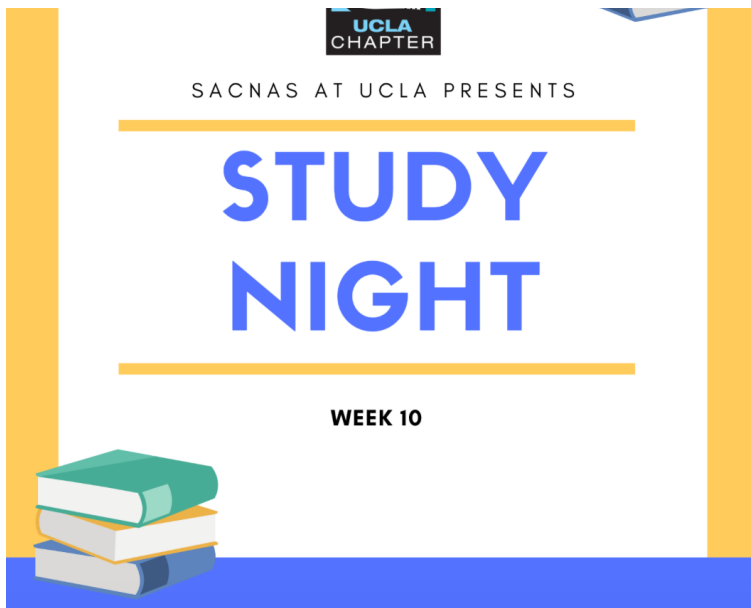
We will be having a social hour so you can get to know your fellow Sacnistas and take time to destress.
